MEDICAL HISTORIES

The **Membership Application Form** also includes a medical questionnaire. **EVERY child that attends the club MUST** have had this section completed for them. This helps the club deal with any emergencies.

We would also ask that you periodically check to ensure the details we hold are current

PLAYING ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

In the interest of safety we insist that trainers/plimsolls are worn at all sessions. These should also be non-marking.

Unfortunately anyone without proper footwear will be unable to play. It is also preferable that t-shirts (not white) and shorts/skirts are worn. You can expect to play your best if your body is constricted by your clothes.

We also ask that t-shirts be tucked into shorts/skirts as bats can catch on them and launch themselves into the air.

Don't worry if you don't have your own bat. The club can lend these to you free of charge.

It is probably best to wait a few weeks anyway. Purchasing a suitable bat can be very complicated and purchasing one at a local sports shop is not advised.

We really do hope that you enjoy yourself and please do remember to ask if there is anything else you need.
